Subject: Ramola D Freedom of Movement Violated

Ramola Dharmaraj, commonly known as Ramola D, is known for her fierce journalism confronting government and other abuses, as a whistleblower, without fear or repercussions.

Ramola has reported that a neighbor of hers made false accusations to the police and her husband, and she was falsely detained by the police and placed into a psych ward on a 72-hour plus hold.

On Tuesday, April 19, 2022, Ramola has been released. She will share her story very soon. Ramola has also asked me and others that this be made public. I am aware that many have been concerned which of course I am sure she is grateful. But others have expressed concern that maybe she confronted too much and maybe she should not do that. She has confronted before.

Let me tell you. I have first-hand knowledge as Ramola called me from the hospital on Sunday and we spoke. It took me a few seconds to process what I was hearing. I always have had confidence in Ramola in her stable approach, yet yes very much fearless confronting. And I have a similar approach.

And only those that spoke to her while in the hospital, while being wrongly detained **without Ramola knowing the outcome**, can speak to this next sentence.

In the moment, *in the moment*, – on Sunday while being wrongly detained without Ramola knowing the outcome, she was as cool as a cucumber. I actually also have a message she left. She knew this was a big story. She had every confidence on the outcome that she would be released and this would just add to the wrongful acts to her that she will report on and publish.

My only advice to Ramola on that call, she already knew. Get names. Not only for the story later, but the medical officials will tread more carefully as they know there will be accountability.

My expectations of Ramola are high, and she exceeded my expectations.
