Re: Public Record Request BHCSQ-2024-208

Dear Ramola D:

This letter is in regard to the above-referenced public record request received by the Department of Public Health (“DPH” or “the Department”) on April 3, 2024. This request has been assigned a tracking number: **BHCSQ-2024-208**. Specifically, you requested:

“In light of the Freedom of Information Act, I would like to request the following records:

1. The contract and licensing agreement that Massachusetts Government or the Mass Department of Public Health has with Midwest Medical Transport Co. an ambulance company for state transport or any other kind of transport-of-bodies services;
2. The Section 12 form or other kind of State authorizing form used by Midwest Medical Transport Co. in rendering unconscious, capturing, manhandling, strapping down, and trafficking my physical living body from the premises of South Shore Hospital on the night of 12-20-2022, or, variably, 12-21-2022 (based on which facility's storytelling has been documented by Midwest, South Shore, Bournewood or by the DPH, DMH, QPD, MSP, or other Mass Gov entity involved).
3. The annual report or other kind of report including said capture, trafficking and sale of my physical living body from South Shore Hospital ED to Bournewood Hospital, the Emerson I Building in its statistical or qualitative tabulations and incident reports, offering any kind of "reason" for said unlawful capture, trafficking, and sale. [It is obviously trafficking and sale (Modern Medical Slavery) when a knocked-unconscious,

already kidnapped and trafficked human body is re-grabbed and re-kidnapped and taken to another Maximum Security Psychiatric Prison charging \$1500 a day and held there unlawfully without ability to leave for 8 days.]

4. The contract and licensing agreement, current, which Mass Govt or the Department of Public Health has with Brewster Ambulance for ambulance or state transport services.
5. The contract and licensing agreement which Mass Govt or the Department of Public Health has with Quincy District Court permitting them to call in to South Shore Hospital and "refer" my kidnap-and-trafficking sale to them as an involuntary Section 12, and the Section 12 form/other authorizing form therefore used by Quincy District Court--in fact, by a certain Chelsea Lloyd, LSW, notated as making this call for QDC, the actual Form therefore used by QDC, Chelsea Lloyd, or/and Brewster Ambulance in forcing through a first involuntary knocking-unconscious, manhandling, strapping, capture, trafficking and sale of my physical living body from Quincy District Court premises to South Shore Hospital on 12-20-2022. ”

On April 10, 2024, my colleague, Marita Callahan reached out to you via email for clarification of your public record request and you responded:

“... Yes, I am seeking any and all contracts and agreements which Brewster Ambulance and Midwest Medical Transport have with the Department of Public Health or Massachusetts Government; I understand the License to operate is granted by DPH; if the License granted Is the Licensing Agreement then yes I am interested in seeing that Licensing Agreement. Hope this helps.”

After a comprehensive search, the Department has not identified any records in its custody and control that are responsive to items 1, 2, 3, and 5 of your request. DPH does not have any contracting or licensing agreement with Midwest Medical Transport Company.

Enclosed is 1 pdf (24 pages) responsive to your request for item 4, the contract agreement and a copy of the current license for Brewster Ambulance Service Inc, the production of which completes DPH's response to your request. The Department has not withheld or redacted any documents from this response.

The Department reserves the right to retrieve any exempted, privileged, or otherwise protected materials inadvertently included in this production. Any such production is not, and shall not be considered or deemed, a waiver of any applicable privileges or protections from disclosure.

DPH now considers this public record request closed. The Department reserves the right to retrieve any exempted, privileged, or otherwise protected materials inadvertently included in this production. Any such production is not, and shall not be considered or deemed, a waiver of any applicable privileges or protections from disclosure.

If you wish to challenge this response, and your request was received in writing, you may appeal to the Supervisor of Records following the procedure set forth in 950 CMR 32.08, a copy of which is attached. Pursuant to G. L. c. 66, § 10A, you may also seek judicial review by commencing a civil action in Suffolk Superior Court.
