We received your February 24, 2025, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request on February 25, 2025, which seeks the following:

“In relation to the USAF AFRL contract with General Dynamics numbered FA8650-13-6368, please provide the following RFP Letters with all financial information and Statements of Objectives:

1&2) RFP New Task Order 01 Letter: Request for Task Order 0001 Proposal and Statement of Work; & Statement of Objectives associated with the RFP for Task Order 0001;

3&4) RFP New Task Order 02 Letter: Request for Task Order 0002 Proposal and Statement of Work; & Statement of Objectives associated with the RFP for Task Order 0002;

5&6) RFP New Task Order 03 Letter: Request for Task Order 0003 Proposal and Statement of Work; & Statement of Objectives associated with the RFP for Task Order 0003;

7&8) RFP New Task Order 04 Letter: Request for Task Order 0004 Proposal and Statement of Work; & Statement of Objectives associated with the RFP for Task Order 0004;

9) Statement of Objectives associated with the RFP for Task Order 0005;

10) Statement of Objectives associated with the RFP for Task Order 0006;

11) Statement of Objectives associated with the RFP for Task Order 0007;

12) Statement of Objectives associated with the RFP for Task Order 0008;

13) Also, The (winning offeror/General Dynamics') Technical and Cost Proposals on all 8 Task Order Statements of Work on this contract, FA8650-13-6368, if available;

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14) Also, the overarching Request for Proposal on the whole contract;

15) Also, any other Task Order RFP Letters, Statements of Objectives, Task Order Statements of Work, and Final Technical and Scientific Reports, if any exist above Task Orders 0001-0008, Task Orders and Final reports for which were sent to me on my earlier query, on March 21-22, 2024;

16.) Also, please provide information on Areas of Operation of all and each of these (all) Task Orders. Thanks very much. (Date Range for Record Search: From 01/01/1990 To 02/24/2025).”

The request was assigned control number 2025-03190-F ST3. Please use this number when referring to your request.

Based on the information you have requested, we placed your request in the Complex processing track. A complex request can take substantial time and cause significant impact on responding units. Complications and delays are likely. Records sought are massive in volume. Multiple organizations must review/coordinate on requested records. Records are classified; originated with a nongovernment source; are part of the Air Force’s decision-making process; or are privileged.

We estimate we will provide a response to your request within 30 working days. Our policy is to process requests within their respective tracks in the order in which we receive them. FOIA requests are processed as quickly as possible. We will advise you if we cannot provide a response within the FOIA statutory timeline.

The FOIA Fee Restriction prevents DoD Components from charging commercial or “other” requesters search fees, or representatives of the news media or educational requesters duplication fees if a response does not occur within 30 working days for unusual circumstances (documents not located with the office processing the FOIA request, the responsive records are voluminous, or required consultation with another agency). Fee restrictions do not apply if responsive records total more than 5,000 pages, and this office has made three or more good-faith attempts to discuss with you, how to effectively limit the scope of your request.

We have placed you in the “Educational or Noncommercial Scientific Institution or News Media” fee category for processing. Under this category, you may be charged for all duplication (paper) costs. The first 100 pages of duplication are furnished without charge. We will process your request for a Fee Waiver when we receive a valid contract number.

In your request you provided the following contract number FA8650-13-6368. Our office conducted a search for the contract and is unable to locate it. Therefore, we request that you provide our office with the below:


- **Please verify and provide the correct contract number.**
