SUBJECT: Contract FA8650-13-D-6368, Request for Task Order (0006) Proposal and Statement of Work (SOW)

1. In accordance with Clause B040 "Ordering Procedures", the Air Force hereby requests a technical proposal, SOW, and cost proposal for the attached Statement of Objectives (SOO), "Directed Energy Bioeffects Research – Novel Direct Energy Weapon Effects," dated 7 August 2014.
2. Please ensure the technical proposal clearly details the effort to be performed under each task. Additionally, your firm shall comply with all applicable DoD regulations and laws governing the access to and handling of all information in the performance of this task order. Your firm shall train personnel in and follow appropriate operations security (OPSEC) measure during the performance of this task order. OPSEC requirement must be addressed in the SOW.
3. Be advised that your proposal is not considered to be based on adequate price completion. Therefore, the proposal should provide clear insight into all cost elements (i.e. labor categories/hours, rates, travel, materials, subcontracting, etc.). The threshold for obtaining certified cost or pricing data is \$700,000. Please provide the same level of detail for subcontractor proposals. For any subcontracts proposed, the cost proposal must contain a subcontractor analysis IAW FAR 15.404-3(b).
4. It is anticipated that the program will be Top Secret/SCI/SAP/SAR. The DD254 of the basic contract will apply to this task order.
5. Information involved in this research effort will be subject to Export Control (International Traffic in Arms Regulation (ITAR) 22 CFR 120-131, or Export Administration Regulations (EAR) 15 CFR 710-774). Please submit a DD Form 2345 with your task order proposal.
6. The period of performance (PoP) for this task order will be **sixty-three (63)** months. The anticipated technical period of performance is sixty (60) months, with an additional three (3) months for preparation, review, revision, and submittal of the approved final technical report.
7. The anticipated Government budget for this effort is \$10.409M.
