Dear Sophie, and all the other Sophies and Sophie-sisters,

Thought I'd take a few minutes to write to you about this year ahead. As you all know, the CIA, FBI, DHS, and DOD, DARPA et al, who embarked on cloning humans back in the 1940s maybe 1930s [pinprick on my 4th finger, right hand, 7:35 pm--there is a plane hovering above wanting readings--sad! Foreign students however seem to have been targeted in many different ways and one is, their kids, many of their kids have been cloned. Anyway, Sophie, I want you to look ahead and think about your life in the future--for just a few moments this year. It is hard for all of us to look into the future. I know you are interested in Government. International Law is needed. But this Government structure is problematic. When I look ahead and try to imagine your future, I feel you would be happy doing intellectual things plus helping people--so there are many possibilities, surely. Teaching at the school or college level could be very rewarding. It would also offer you some freedom during the day or week. There are many creative things one could envision also in traveling, becoming travel guides for schools or colleges or groups of people in continuing ed. settings, working in design in some way in architecture, or home decor, or interior design or painting murals (like your cousin Samantha--or is it Sarah--my cousin Mona's kids), or doing backyard and garden landscaping design (our backyard needs some, front yard too...), becoming a naturalist, or field geologist--anyway I am probably speaking more to the other Sophies and you already have an idea of what you want to do. Whatever you decide, please come home for your next degree. We could take the train in to Boston. I hope to be teaching again soon, and if not, I will be busy going in to explore Boston's history and literary history. If your dad is lucky he will come with me. If not not. He owes me many apologies and many explanations. It is not Comprehensible, what he has done here--walking out of the house and taking you with him

just because 2 assholes (I am presuming 2, may have been 4) from the Quincy Police Department and the Boston FBI came here and BS'd to him about the need to leave home and leave them to their critical "investigation" of me--after which they went full Monty and unleashed clones and other strangers on me, and the children, and arranged for Mushrooms, Haldoling and Gaslighting--"Oh we Must Neurotunnel the Woman Journalist and Poet and Fiction Writer and Children's Art Teacher into oblivion." Your twenties are important, Sophie. When I look back on mine, I realize that is the decade when we struggle through and try to find our careers and professions, the field we want to stay in. We do our Master's degrees then. We decide if we want to do more studying and in what field precisely. And we meet the people whom we are attracted to and end up marrying. Some have children right away too, in their 20s. [We might have, but your dad went to law school.] Finding the right person too--or coming across them--sometimes is preceded by a lot of heartache and hanging out with the wrong person or staying too long at a spot which is going nowhere. [Many women spend their 30s this way actually--and men too; but I seem to recall your Aunt Sharola doing precisely that as well.] Your twenties are precious, don't waste them. And don't look to your 30s to have kids, plan to get married in your mid-20s and have kids shortly after maybe within the first 2-3 years. Children bring couples together and keep them together. You can grow your career along with having children. It is difficult but that is how Life works. Our parents have done it, now we have these years and lives and choices for ourselves. I had you at 39 only because a few things happened to keep us from having kids at 28 or 29 as might have happened had your dad not gone to law school. Obviously, there are no regrets here, you came when we were 39, your coming to us has been nothing but a Joy and a blessing in our lives. Complicated and I will speak more about it to you sometime. But we greatly wanted a child, and we were blessed. As you may know, I was teaching CW at the time I was pregnant, and picked up again when you were 5 months old. I continued teaching and working on my writing when you were little, right up to when we moved here and I was trying to finish a novel and write children's books and finish a poetry project--I taught art classes for kids then, nearby, and was planning to go back to teaching and apply for CW jobs in Boston. It was difficult, but many young couples work through these kinds of difficulties together. Having children is for your 20s and early 30s, just as building your career is. So don't hesitate to think of both of these going together--it Can be done. It is also a great joy, having children, it is a way to be happy and many young people don't know this. Of course, only with the right person. But I hope you will look forward to these things in your 20s, finding the right guy to fall in love with and get married, and having children soon after. [You will have to have an army with you to make sure your placenta and child's cord isn't stolen....] I will be there, for sure.

Your teens like your pre-teens are your dreaming years, when you read, and keep journals and field notebooks and sketchbooks and take classes and explore--and you can and should take classes outside academe as well well into your 20s, art classes for instance, and poetry, everyone should take these--other classes too I mean--but your teens are precious years for yourself.

People retire in the US at 65--not if you're a famous writer or poet and get a teaching job or artist or politician--so that would mean you get about 30 years or 40 in a single career and time to write too, if you want one day to become a writer. With kids women often go part-time in the early childhood years. And you don't need to imagine a single career. It helps, in the beginning, to get your professional degrees. But there are no laws there. Those are things you work out over time with your spouse and your family. People do change careers and should if they are not satisfying and meaningful. People do go back to school later in their 30s and 40s and 50s--and these are good things. So there are no rules set in stone and I don't mean to imply such. I wanted to bring up this notion of Time though. There is a Time for everything, and our own inner biological clocks will tell us when it is Time to do something...

Do not fall for the crazy behavior shown in shows like Summer I turned Pretty and Gossip Girl though--people don't have wild romances like that in high school or college and it is best not to let anyone get physical with you in either spot. [Remember what I told you once about that.] You need to focus on your life and career and future and immature boys in school or college are not the route to either. Master's programs--grad school: maybe. You might run into some thoughtful, serious men in grad school. [Law school ends relationships and marriages or destroys them.] Throughout, You need to be thinking, not just reacting, and you need to realize what a responsibility we women have, with our bodies. We get to decide when the time is right, not Men. Having a child for instance is a choice both make together but the woman makes essentially, based on her career--and conveys to the man. Men cannot call the shots. Women must, within the marriage. [Didn't happen with your dad and me, certain other things happened--including the murder of your Uncle Ned, which was thought of as a suicide in the family, I think he was targeted and murdered, he was 28, he was smart, and he was on the verge of returning to school I think, grad school, he would have become a high school teacher and writer I think--great tragedy there in your father's family and in all of our lives, it stopped many things then.] Other things to speak of when you are home sometime. But it is important to tell you that it is true, the woman's body is more important, when you both think

of having kids. It is important for me to tell you this. We as women are very important--to the future of our species and humanity as a whole--and we are constantly being DISAPPEARED. And that is WRONG. Men need to back down and work to keep ego under control when it comes to when to have kids and men need to be guided by women sometimes in these matters, even guided into doing things together. [I was often on my own, doing things your dad should have been with me for.] [Your dad actually didn't seem to know he was married.] And of course it is not just about when to have kids, it is about everything, about listening to each other. About working as a family, rather than as just one person.

But listen to your inner Clock, your inner Metronome, your Inner Timekeeper. Time has us in its hands, Time is always trying to tell us something. And in our women's bodies is Time; Time is in us, and will tell us what we need to hear, but only if we pause to listen. Have you read the Ecclesiastes' passage on Time..." [Ecclesiastes 3 NIV - A Time for Everything - There is a time - Bible Gateway](#). Do you have a King James version of the Bible? Read it for the music and writing. We have the Nag Hammadi at home, read that too...I've just ordered and gotten a few books by and on Rumi, the Persian poet...you must read his poetry.

Anyway, I wanted also to send a few links to you and the children so you can all see and meet each other soon.

My cell is still on the blink --CIA that is--so I can't send all the pics but you recall I sent you links to a shared album last year.

Cannot find that link now but it has the pics of a few of the Sophies who visited here in 23 and 24.

Sophie--I am maintaining links and pics here too of the sisters and some local coverage. You can see a second Sophie's graduation in 2023 and pics of the 2022 National merit scholarship nominees in 2022.
